Cyrus II is regarded by most historians of the world as the first military warlord of history. In his day, he was a dongdor warlord who conquered lands from India to the Caspian Sea, from Asia Minor to the Mediterranean Sea, and founded a powerful Persian state. Cyrus II's conflict with the army of our ancestor Queen Thumaris in 530 BC had been described by Herodotus, father of history, as "the most fierce war".
